Dear KG1 Parents,

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you and your child to the new academic year.

The beginning of KG1 is an exciting next step in your child's Early Years journey. Our priority is to ensure that children begin the year feeling secure, confident and ready to engage fully with the opportunities ahead. This letter confirms your child's transition group and timings, alongside some key practical information to help you prepare for the start of term.

Even if you are already familiar with NLCS Dubai, please do take a few moments to read the information below, as some arrangements may differ from previous years.

KG1 Transition Group and Timings

Your child has been allocated to KG1 Group B.

Date	Timing	Information
Tuesday 1st September	13:00-14:00	Parents remain with their child for this first session
From Wednesday 2nd September	07:50-14:20	Normal KG1 full school day

The first session provides children with an opportunity to become familiar with their new classroom, teachers and environment alongside a parent before beginning their full school day from Wednesday.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Early Years students have their own dedicated drop-off and collection windows, so the wider school collection code system will not be in use for Pre-KG and KG1. Parents or authorised adults may park and come directly to the designated Early Years door to collect their child. Please ensure that your child's class teacher has been given the names of all adults who are permitted to collect them.

Lunch and Snack

For your child's transition session on Tuesday 1st September, please send them to school with:

- A named water bottle
- A light, healthy snack

Please remember that NLCS Dubai is a pork, nut and sesame-free school.

School lunches for KG1 will begin on Wednesday 2nd September, when children commence their full school day. From this date:

- Children registered for a school lunch with Harness Foods will have this delivered to them in the Early Years Dining Area.
- Alternatively, you may provide a packed lunch from home.

Children are given ample time to eat, with gentle encouragement and support from staff. We do, however, ask that portion sizes are manageable for your child within the designated lunch period.

Spare Uniform

In Early Years, accidents and spills are a normal part of busy school life. These will always be handled discreetly and sensitively, allowing children to change quickly and comfortably before continuing with their day.

On your child's first day, please provide a spare uniform or set of clothes containing:

- 2 pairs of underwear
- 1 pair of socks
- 1 pair of shorts, trousers or leggings
- 1 T-shirt

Please ensure that:

- These items are provided in a sealed, clear, wipeable bag.
- The bag is given to the class teacher or teaching assistant.
- Items are packed as compactly as possible, as the bag will be stored in your child's locker.

If your child needs to change during the school day, their used clothing will be sent home in a sealed zip-lock bag, together with a note identifying anything that needs to be replenished.

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PE and Swimming

During the first week of school, your child's class teacher will share the days on which your child has PE and swimming. On PE and swimming days:

- Children should arrive at school wearing their NLCS PE kit.
- Girls should have their hair tied up securely.
- Swimming kit and towels should be clearly named and brought to school in a waterproof bag.
- Children may wear their swimwear underneath their PE kit on swimming days.
- Please send underwear in your child's bag for them to change into afterwards.
- Children should not wear jewellery or watches.

Swimming is an important part of our Early Years PE curriculum, supporting children to develop water confidence and refine their swimming skills. If your child is well enough to attend school, we expect them to participate in their scheduled swimming lesson.

We look forward to working in close partnership with you throughout the year and to seeing your child grow in confidence, independence and curiosity. I am very much looking forward to welcoming them back to Early Years and to all that the year ahead will bring.
